II. Policy Statement

The policy of the Regional Council is that the Midwest Region will adhere to USPC Bylaws (2.1) with the following additions.

III. Amplifying Instructions & Guidelines

- A. The Vice Regional Supervisor may serve unlimited terms.
- B. In order that finances are not an inhibiting factor in election of the VRS, the Region will pay for expenses as defined in Policy MW0700.
- C. The region will have an additional Vice Regional Supervisor under the following circumstances:
 - 1. If the current VRS does not wish to not advance to the position of RS, the Region will elect a RS-in-training who will also serve as VRS.
 - 2. If the workload become more that the RS and VRS can comfortably handle.
 - 3. The current RS or VRS plan to retire, a VRS-in-training will be brought in one year before their retirement.
- D. The Vice President of Regional Administration may remove the Vice Regional Supervisor, with or without cause by request of the Regional Council.

IV. Delegation Of Authority

The Vice President for Regional Administration shall have the overall responsibility for enforcing this policy.
